- Management reserves the right to combine or cancel any classes in accordance to MTHJA rules.

- Derby 2'6" and 2': Ribbons for top 1st – 6th placings & Prize for 1st and prize money.

- Prizes for Champion in all divisions.

- Rider / Horse must show in 4 of the 8 Silent Run Show Series shows to be eligible for end of the circuit awards.

- ASTM-SEI approved helmets must be worn at all times

- Martingales are not permitted in U/S.

- Unconventional hunter tack or equipment will only be permitted at the judge's discretion.
